If the lack of culture in teaching is not corrected in time, it will lead to the lack of culture in international exchange: cultural input is greater than cultural output, resulting in the lack of culture. Lack of culture is an unequal phenomenon in cultural exchange under the background of globalization. It is the aphasia of cultural subjects, which seriously damages the spread of Chinese culture in the world.^[2]

2.2 Harm to cultural inheritance - cultural colonization

The West led by the United States has received the support of political power and military economic hegemony, and has obtained the discourse hegemony of world culture. 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conception in Jay Chou's songs. How pathetic!

2.3 Impact on national spirit - cultural extinction

The result of years of cultural colonization is that foreign culture grows exponentially, while domestic culture is diluted again and again, and finally dies under the encirclement of foreign culture. This is not alarmist. Many teenagers have changed under the influence of Western Culture: in the business halls of McDonald's and KFC all over the country, people can see a long list of teenagers: Coca Cola has become their basic drink; Jeans, rock music, break dancing and performing arts are the most popular fashion among teenagers today; The temptation of Hollywood movies, Disney and NBA to teenagers is unstoppable; Valentine's day, April Fool's day and Christmas are very popular among teenagers, while traditional and national festivals are ignored. Various scenes make people feel like they are in a foreign country, as if we are not facing Chinese teenagers, but the next generation of Americans. Teenagers are guided by American values, ways of thinking and behavior.^[4] "If we can't teach students how to introduce Chinese traditional culture to foreigners in English in foreign language teaching, if we can't effectively resist the colonization of western culture, the consequences will be unimaginable.
